A passionate and dedicated supporter of the game, Dan has a long association as a player, coach and official, growing the sport of Basketball in Queensland and Australia. He is well respected in the Basketball community with extensive contacts throughout Australia and the USA. Dan has an eye for identifying talent and potential in juniors. His knowledge of the game and his ability to analyze strengths and weaknesses of players is backed by his extensive network of American college coaches seeking Australian talent for their programs.

A coach for over thirty six years, Dan is a very technical coach, possessing an indepth understanding of the fundamentals of the game and capable of assessing player weaknesses and strengths as part of the process of developing a players game. This is an asset to improve player opportunities to attract offers of College scholarships. One of his specialty areas of development is developing pure shooting form. Dan coached his daughter through her representative career from U12's to U21 and then senior women's basketball, helped secure a scholarship with NCAA D1 Women's College team Seattle University. Courtney received over 20 offers before chosing Seattle. The reason for success ultimately was her shooting ability from anywhere on court, consistent scoring, indepth knowledge of the game, basketball IQ and broad skillset including defence and rebounding.

As a player Dan played State Basketball for Queensland U20's under former NBL coach Dave Claxton. As a senior he played in the inaugral State League in Queensland from 1986 till 1993 initially with the Toowoomba Mountaineers and then the Sunshine Coast Sea Eagles. He has coached Division one representative teams in the BQJBC and State Championships from U12's through to U18 women as well as U21 women, senior SBL women and assistant coach for Men's and Women's QBL for the Sunshine Coast Phoenix. Dan has been involved in several State programs in Queensland: U16 boys and girls State trials and State Squad, U18 girls State trials and squad trainings, U14

FDP (Future Development Program) coach, SPP (State Performance Program) and an Academy coach for Sunshine Coast Phoenix Basketball Association.

Programs Dan has been involved in on a College level include organisation and hosting of the first ever NCAA D1 women's college exposure camp in Australia, on the Sunshine Coast Qld in September 2017 with sixteen D1 coaches attending. From the thirty girls who attended the Sunshine Coast camp, 11 have picked up scholarships in the 2018 Class with a number of 2019's currently receiving offers.

Dan's key focus has been developing our women's pathways in Australian basketball but he also has an interest in the men's programs. His experience with College Basketball and connections are invaluable to ANZ Basketball Scouts.
